TEHRAN - Over 850 enthusiastic art collectors of Iranian modern and contemporary art from all around the world were present at the 5th TEHRAN AUCTION and drove the total sales up by almost 80% above the estimates. 80 works of art by 65 artists; which consisted of 76 paintings, 4 sculptures, reached a total of 7,350,000 USD. This was almost double the original estimate around 4,000,000 USD. This collection also had 15 paintings by Iranian academic masters including one by the celebrated Qajar court artist Mohammad Ghaffari (Kamal-al-Molk 1845-1940). The auctuineer was Mr. Hossein Pakdel. Among the 80 works of art, 5 sales records were set for master artists, a measure of the quality of the works offered. The audience applauded as the untitled Sohrab Sepehri's were sold for 870,000 USD and the Manouchehr Yektai Untitled still life for 450,000 USD with overall 19 collectors bidding for the pieces.
